I sat today upon a high cliff - watching for whales! Not a typical event for me but a memorable one for sure!

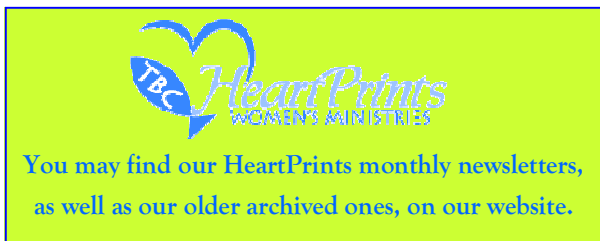
